In Genesis 1-2, we read about how God created everything. If you haven't read these chapters before, you might want to take a look at them.

In the first book of the Bible called Genesis, we see how the world was created. With little effort but wonderful creativity, God creates the heavens and the earth and everything in it. The breadth and depth of what God was able to get done in just six days is sobering for any results-oriented, type-A person. Talk about cranking it out! But then again, there is no one like Him. He's God.

As God creates the world, a recurring phrase appears. In fact, six times after God creates something the Bible says, "and God saw that it was good." From the light, to the sea, to the sky, to the land, to the sun, the moon, the stars, and the animals, God's assessment of what He's created is always the same: it is good. God is pleased. Then on the sixth day, God creates humanity. And God is so pleased by what He's created that His assessment changes. He looks at humanity and says that we're "very good." But then something unexpected happens.
